## **Butterfly** (butterflee/butterie)

Butterflies are grown up caterpillars.

### **Favourite Food**

Butterflies look for sugary food, called nectar, in the centre of flowers. Bright sweet-smelling flowers attract butterflies into a garden.

They are also looking for the right plant on which to lay their eggs – some caterpillars are very fussy about what they eat.

### **Where Are They?**

Caterpillars (oobits) are found on leaves – look for big nibbled holes! Stinging nettles, nasturtiums and cabbages are good plants for caterpillars.

### **Keeping Safe**

Birds like to eat butterflies.  
Some butterflies have big eye-like patterns on their wings to frighten birds away.



### **Try This**



Put sugar solution (1 tsp of sugar in 2 tbsp of water) into the lid of a jam jar and place outside on pieces of coloured paper or cloth. Which colours do the butterflies like best?



See if you can find butterfly eggs and a chrysalis in your garden.
