Ladybird (Clock-leddy or leddy launners)

Ladybirds are very helpful to gardeners.

Favourite Food

They eat green and black aphids.

Getting About

Ladybirds fly. Their wings are hidden under the colourful case.

Watch a ladybird take off.
See the wing cases open
and the wings pop out.

Keeping Safe

Their red colour is a warning to predators that might eat them.

If a ladybird is attacked by a bird or a spider it lies on its back and squirts smelly fluid from its knees!

Try This



Lay a light coloured sheet on the ground under a bush and gently shake the bush. Use a magnifying glass to have a closer look at your finds. See if you can find the most common seven-spotted ladybird.



Gently place a ladybird on your hand, wish a wish and let it fly away. Good luck will come from the direction in which it flies.
