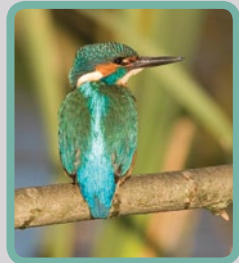

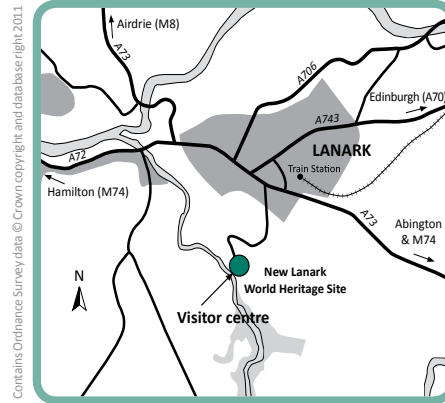

By car

One mile (1.6 km) south of Lanark, off the A73. Follow brown signs for New Lanark World Heritage Site. The Falls of Clyde Visitor Centre is located within the village of New Lanark. Follow the badger signs to the Dyeworks building.

By train and bus

Train and bus station located in Lanark. Regular bus from Lanark to New Lanark (Service SPT 135).

* The visitor centre is unmanned and an honesty box is in operation.

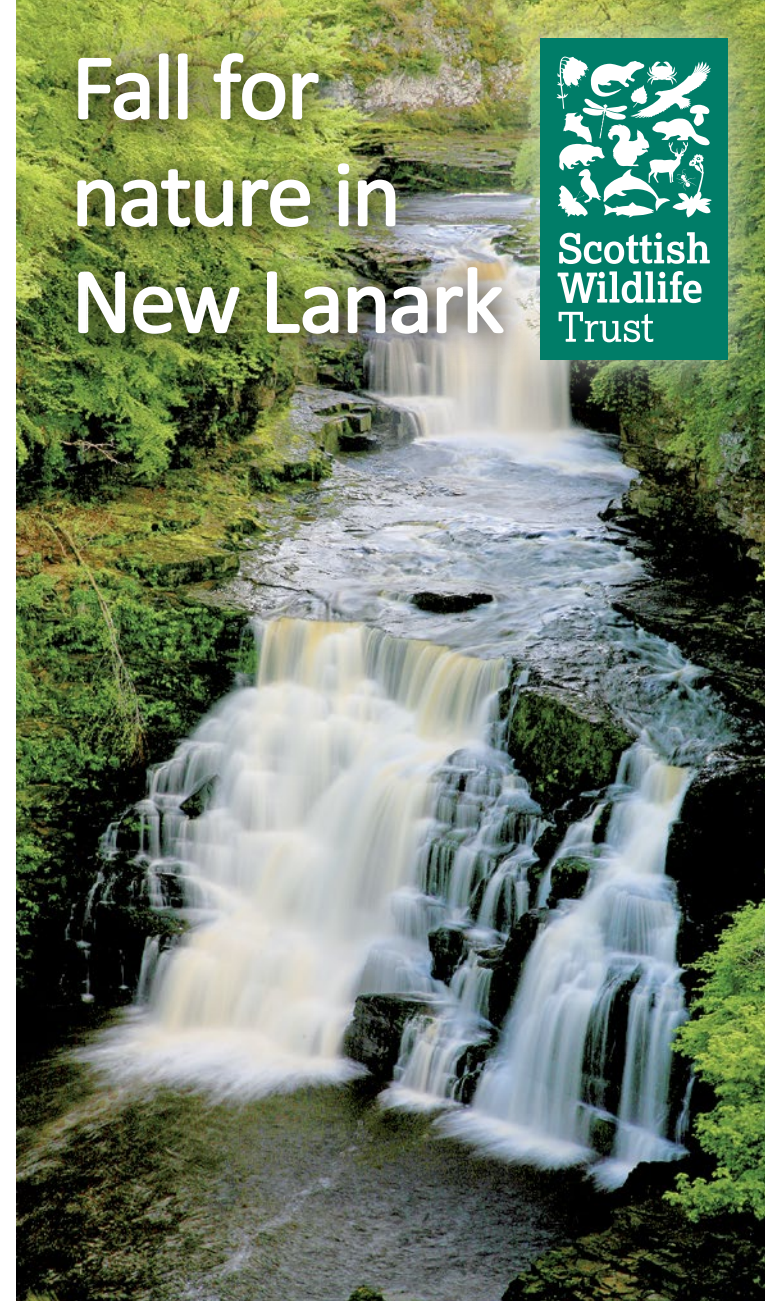
